

The challenge of the Holos: the theory of the moment is not the moment of the theory

Abstract

The Logos-civilisation of today abhors and chokes from the closeness created by itself. The ability of the digital elite to break out from the edge of chaos – from the point of bifurcation – and reach the equilibrium of a higher order, depends on experiencing the trial of the spiritual break-trough while living with the experience of the un-sustainable existence.

Man will only be able to open itself to the infinite possibilities offered by the model of the multidimensional existence, if he or she opens him- or herself, if reconnects him- or herself to the cosmic order, with which the Logos-civilisation last contact, while, quite paradoxically, created a realty behind the symbols: representing itself – during which it raised ontology into the Holos, while gnoseology stuck or stayed in the Logos. This paradox could be resolved, which again a paradox itself, by the theory of the Holos, in a way which helps the Holos to release itself from necessity of resolving. The many-sheeted existence requires an n-dimensional explanation, through which the unique and incidental dimensions of the subject reality could sublimate into the universal order.
